MV Thailand Food Relief – Evacuation Centres in **Det Udom District, Ubon-Ratchathani Province**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ. Grace and peace to you all in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Amidst the ongoing conflict along the borders of seven provinces in Thailand, over 200,000 people are displaced. Including many families with young children and the elderly have been forced to flee their homes. These displaced families and individuals are now scattered across various temporary safe zones, particularly in the northeastern region of the country.

MV Thailand delivered foodstuffs to a temporary shelter for Christian brothers and sisters in one of those affected areas. From what we saw and experienced first-hand, many of them are in urgent need of basic necessities.

Urgently needed items include:

Dried food / Ready-to-eat meals

Orinking water

Toilet paper

Powdered and carton milk for young children Diapers for infants and the elderly
